ITINERARY

DAY 1 Overnight Flight to Paris

DAY 2 Welcome to Paris

Start the day with a guided sightseeing tour of Paris, a timeless city filled with iconic architecture, exquisite cuisine, chic boutiques, and artistic treasures. Check into your hotel and enjoy a welcome dinner.

DAY 3 Paris Sightseeing

Begin with a buffet breakfast at the hotel and a morning football practice. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame de Paris, which displays its French Gothic architecture, gargoyles, and a spectacular view of Paris. Enjoy dinner in the Latin Quarter, and see the city from the water on an hour-long cruise along the River Seine.

DAY 4 The Louvre Museum

Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the hotel before making your way to the Louvre Museum. Spend the day in the world's largest museum taking in the priceless masterpieces of the world's history. Enjoy dinner in the Montmartre district.

DAY 5 Normandy

Start your day with a buffet breakfast at the hotel before transferring to Normandy. Visit the D-Day Museum in Arromanches and see the American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer which is a World War II cemetery and memorial that honors American troops who died in Europe during World War II. Enjoy dinner and stay overnight in Amiens.

DAY 6 Gameday in Amiens

Meet up with your tour guide for a walking tour of Amiens, and visit Amiens Cathedral, the tallest Gothic church and largest cathedral in France. Fuel up with a pregame meal before heading out for an exhibition game against your French competition. After the game, recharge with a meal and post-game social event.

DAY 7 Paris

Begin the day with breakfast at the hotel before heading back to Paris. Visit the home and gardens of Claude Monet, the founder of French impressionist painting. After dinner, experience the ambiance of the Eiffel Tower at night.

DAY 8 Paris

Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day visiting the Palace of Versailles, the 17th-century chateau of Louis XIV. It served as the kingdom's political capital and the seat of the royal court from 1682 up until the French Revolution. End the day with an awards dinner.

DAY 9 Return to USA
