## ITINERARY

### DAY 1 Overnight Flight to Italy

### DAY 2 Arrive in Italy

Enjoy the rolling hills of Tuscany at the Val D'Orcia park reserve. Later in the day, begin the journey towards the Renaissance hill town of Montepulciano, best known for their wine.

### DAY 3 Siena Sightseeing

Join your tour director for a guided tour of Siena including a private tour of the Palio museum. Take in the opulent architecture – bulbous domes, gothic spires and lacy marble – along with the intricate labyrinth of streets and bridges as well as Church of St. Catherine and Fortezza Medicea.

### DAY 4 Florence Sightseeing

Join a local licensed guide for a tour of Florence, a red-brick splendor set in the rolling green hills of Tuscany. Visit the Giotto's Bell Tower, Gates of Paradise and Brunelleschi's Duomo, which dominates the city's skyline and is full of incomparable art.

### DAY 5 Assisi & Siena Sightseeing

Explore the Basilica of St. Francis, built in the 13th century

to hold the body of St. Francis, the founder of the Franciscan order. A small town of narrow streets and medieval walls, Assisi might never have been famous had it not been for his body being hidden so well that it took 600 years of digging to find.

### DAY 6 Ancient Rome Sightseeing

Travel to Rome and see ancient landmarks, including the Colosseum and the Roman Forum, which provide a glimpse into the life of ancient Romans. Join your tour director to visit more landmarks, including Piazza Navona and the Pantheon.

### DAY 7 Gameday in Rome

It's finally game time! Enjoy a pre-game mass then fuel up with a pre-game meal before taking the field to face off against your Italian competitors. After the game, recharge with a meal and social activity.

### DAY 8 Holy Rome Sightseeing

Accompany a local guide to Vatican City where you'll see St. Peter's Basilica, the Sistine Chapel and the Vatican Museum.
